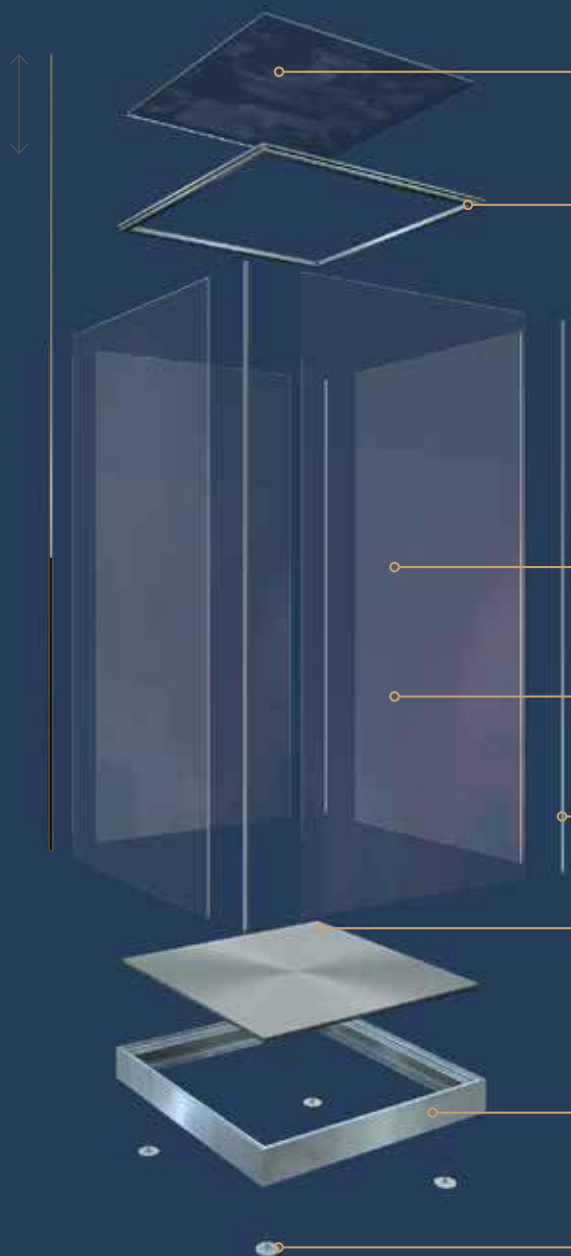

Technology that connects - without glue or fasteners

The FRANK showcase system features our unrivaled slide-in technology.

It requires no screws or gaskets for dustproof and airtight storage and preservation. Insert the minimal aluminum strips into the precisely machined grooves along the panel edges. No wider than the joint between two 8mm panels, these slender extrusions sit flush with the surface upon installation. Most important of all, they provide a precise-fitting connection with the stability of a permanent joint and the flexibility of a quick-release fixture that enables easy disassembly.

FRANK developed a custom base frame that ensures perfect passive humidity control. It includes a discreetly integrated locking drawer hidden behind a panel, along with horizontal ventilation ducts that promote steady air circulation inside the case. The drawer is designed to hold ProSorb or an equivalent desiccant/silica gel. All materials used are free from any gas emissions.

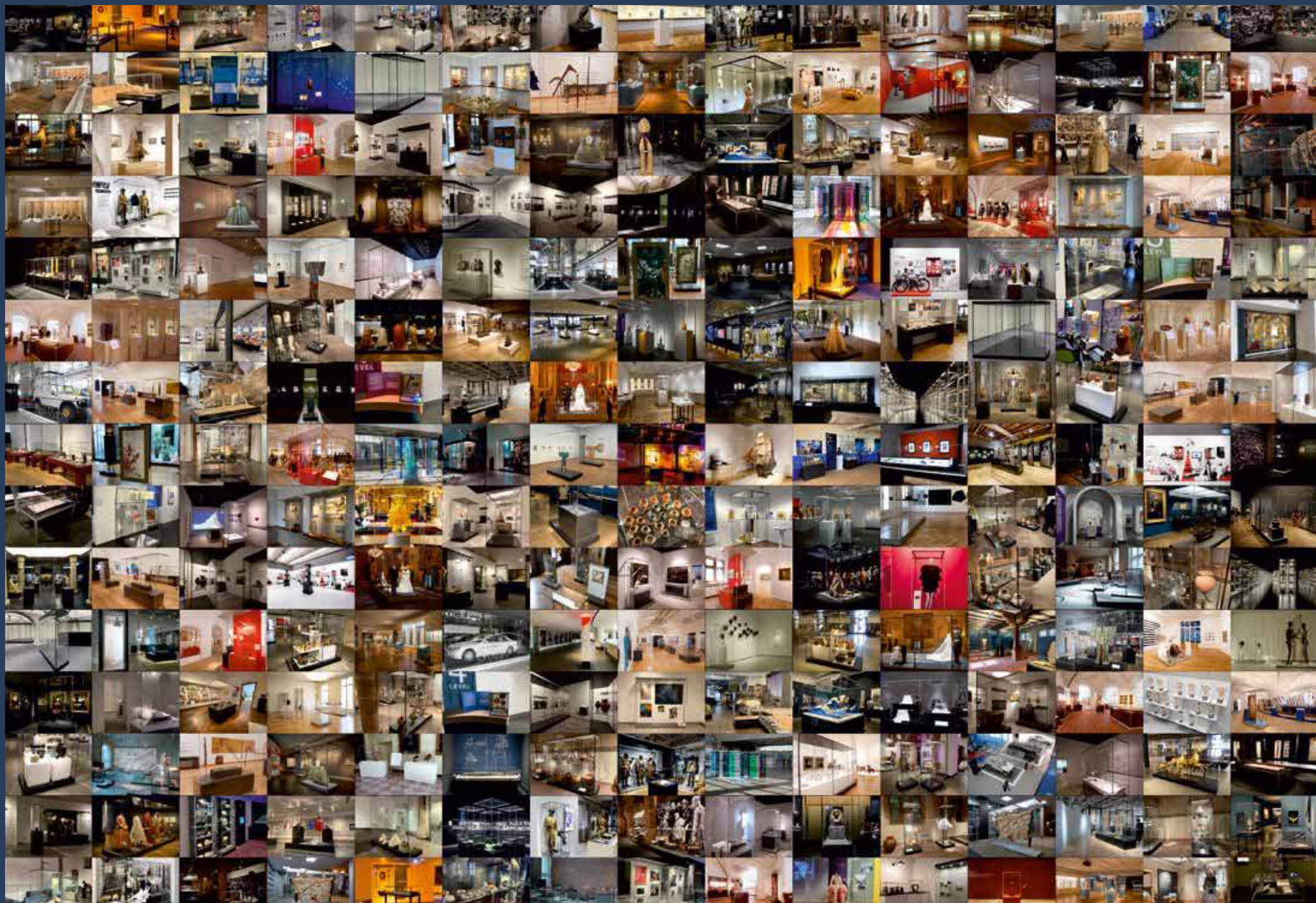

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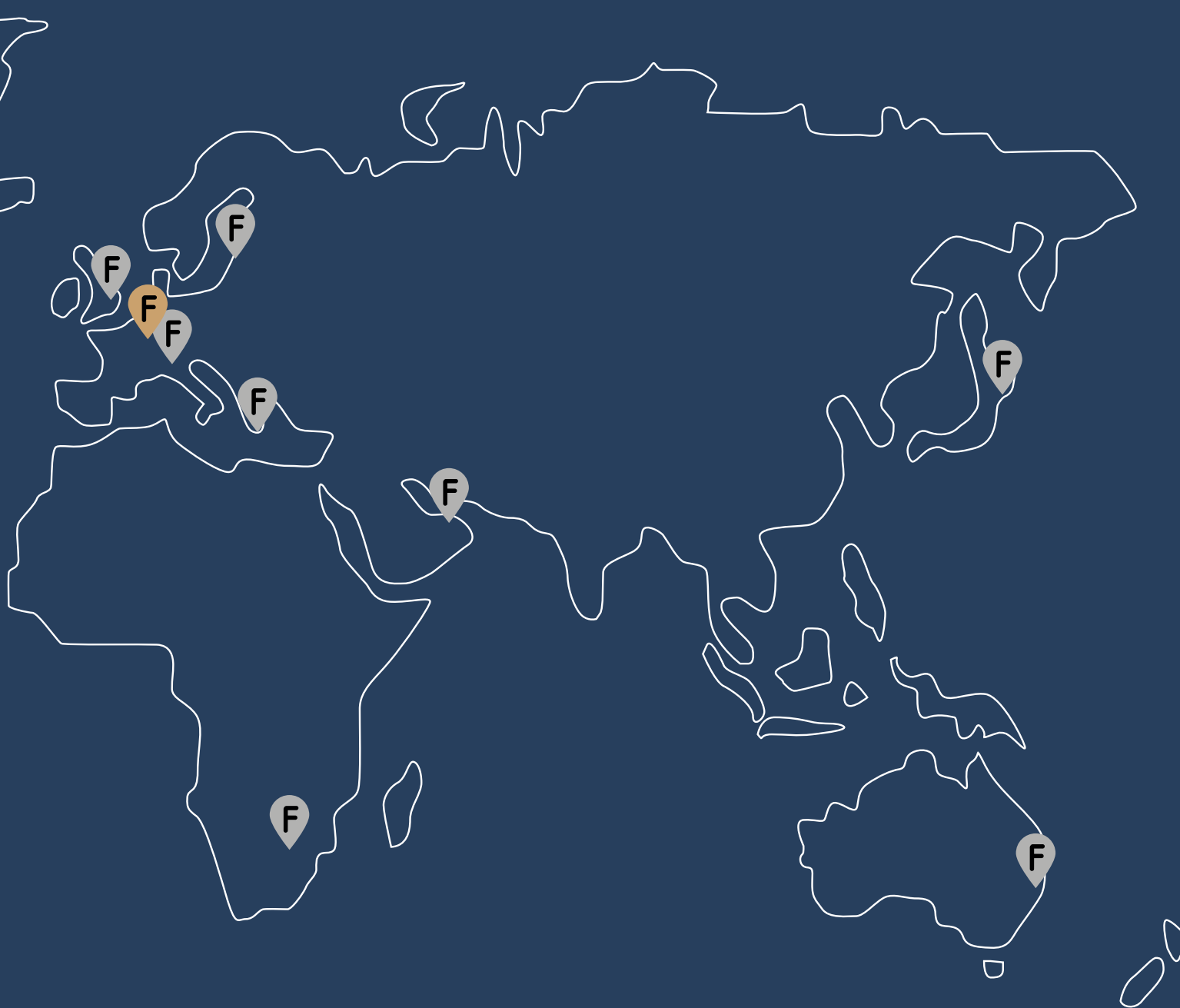


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
